"I Want Candy" was originally recorded in 1965 by the Strangeloves, which is a name the songwriters gave themselves when they decided to record their own song. They had previously written other hits, including "My Boyfriend's Back." There are many covers, notably by the Bow Wow Wows in 1982. The song has a jungle-style beat. Many versions have nothing but drums for the first two chords of each line. The final two D chords include a single strum of C. All strums on the final two Ds are single down strums as follows:
